Recycling Guidelines

Please rinse containers of any liquid and food debris!

Always Recycle: Plastic bottles and containers, food and beverage cans, printer paper, notebook paper, envelopes, magazines, newspaper, food and beverage cartons, glass bottles and containers, and flattened cardboard and paperboard.

Never Recycle: Plastic bags and films, Styrofoam and foam packaging, paper napkins, towels, plates, cups, and tissues, plastic lids, cups, straws, fast food containers, utensils and plates, plastic wrappers and snack bags, food and liquids.



You should **never** recycle these items in single-stream recycling bins. However, you can recycle items, such as plastic bags, separately.
